Daily Suspension & Expulsion

The Board of Trustees

Daily Suspension

A student will be sent home from school if the student becomes physically aggressive, willfully defies authority, is verbally abusive, and displays continued and willful disobedience.

Expulsion

Mandatory expulsion will occur if the student possesses, sells or otherwise furnishes firearms, knife, hypodermic needle, or other dangerous objects. The student unlawfully offered, arranged, or negotiated to sell any controlled substance. The student extorted money from other students, assaulted a teacher, threatened a teacher or students, willfully causing or attempting to cause substantial damage to school property, possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages on school premises, or being under the influence of intoxicating liquor or controlled dangerous substances while on school premises.

Expulsion will take place if these actions occur while on school ground, while going or coming from school, during lunch period or while going to or coming from school sponsored activity.
