Suspension(Additional)

Uniform

Refusal of the student/parent to adhere to the uniform policy will result in a suspension of the student from school. The length of suspension will be determined by the Executive Director. Refusal by the parents to adhere to the uniform policy can result in the student being expelled from the school if they are attending or refusal for admission to the school if they are applying.

Parent Contact

If the school is unable to contact the parents/guardian of a student attending because of the parent not providing an emergency telephone number, a child will be suspended until that information is provided. In cases where the parent is unable to be contacted the school will call the proper authorities(police/DYFS) to make arrangements to have the student transported to their home or suitable alternative site of a relative. Under no circumstance will the school transport the child.

Unpaid monies

If the parent refuses to pay bills to the school(i.e. – lost books, damaged books, damage to school property, unpaid lunch bills, unpaid fundraisers, etc.) the student will be suspended from school for a period to be determined by the Executive Director.

Student Conduct

A student will be suspended for a period of time to be determined by the Executive Director for the following offenses(but not limited to these): fighting, bullying, intimidating, disrespectful towards staff, cheating, stealing, physically aggressive with other students,
