POLICY WHICH IS AN ADDENDUM TO THE ATTENDANCE AND LATENESS POLICY

The Board of Trustees of The Gray Charter School requires that pupils be in attendance for the full school day in order to benefit from the entire instructional program.

According to The Gray Charter School Attendance Policy, if a child misses 9 non-consecutive days the New Jersey Department of Education mandates that they be dropped from the school roll and replaced with a new student.

If a student is late more than 30 days in any one school year, that student will not be permitted to attend the following school year.

All children who are late coming to school will have the amount of minutes that they are late added up and when the time adds up to 9 days or more they will be dropped from the roll and replaced with a new student.
